INTERN INTERVIEW SAMPLE QUESTIONS

Interviewing <u>current</u> interns helps inform your recruitment practices, understand young worker needs and motivations and ensure your interns have a sense of belonging. When interns feel connected to their workplace and colleagues, they are less likely to seek opportunities elsewhere.

- What inspired you to pursue a career in civil engineering? What aspects of civil engineering work are you most passionate about?
- How do you research potential careers?
- What do you value most in a team or colleagues?
- How important is company culture in choosing a job?
- What are the key skills you want to develop further in your career?
- How do you balance your work and personal life, and how important is this balance to you?
- Who or what has the most influence on your career and internship decisions?
- Besides salary, what other benefits, incentives or flexibility options are important to you in a job?
- If you were asked to relocate for a job, what factors influence that decision?
- Describe an ideal internship or job experience for you. What is the most valuable takeaway from an internship experience?
- What kind of career path do you envision for yourself in civil engineering? What industries are you most interested in?
